#### Mr. Jeffrey Cheung Building Your Ideas with Capital

After Jeffrey helped multinational companies to build, invest, integrate ventures in Asia, he founded Crossgate Advisors Limited and is now an active angel investor and a mentor of entrepreneurs in Hong Kong, helping startups to grow, raise funds and exit.

Jeffrey volunteers for the Young Entrepreneurs Development Council and serves as judges in various business plan competitions. He is a member of the Hong Kong Venture Capitalist, Private Equity Association and sat on the Ventures committee from 2008-2013.



#### Mr. Brian Lo

Brian launched Deliveroo Hong Kong in late 2015 and has rapidly grown the business across the region, employing several hundreds of riders and partnering with over 1500 of the city's favorite restaurants to give customers the best food delivery experience in the world. As General Manager, Brian is responsible for everything from operations to staff development to maintaining relationships with clients and customers.

Prior to joining Deliveroo, Brian was a Senior Engagement Manager at McKinsey & Company where he specialized in working with large corporations in need of restructuring around the globe to improve their overall operational capabilities and financial performance in distressed situations.



## Mr. Freeman Ho Is crowdfunding the go-to path for aspired creators?

After graduating from HKUST in 2013, Freeman joined HSBC as a management trainee. He stayed with the bank for 2 years until he was able to devote full-time into his very first start-up company, Darts Connect.

Darts Connect made its first debut on Kickstarter in Dec 2015 where it raised ~\$600,000 hkd from dart enthusiasts from all around the world to give birth to the product that it is today.
