***CEO, Bright Stream Macro Fund***

Ka-Hay has over 25 years of experience in macro trading, starting with JP Morgan in New York and Tokyo. He then moved to Credit Suisse First Boston in Singapore in 1997 and managed its Emerging Market trading desk till 2002. He was the founder and CIO for all macro strategies under PMA Investment Advisors, a Hong Kong-based multi-strategy hedge fund which was successfully acquired by SPARX Group for USD 250m in 2006.

Ka-Hay later became SAC's (renamed to Point72) first PM and Responsible Officer in Hong Kong, with a mandate to build a presence in Asia's macro space. He now manages his own fund, Bright Stream Macro Fund, which was launched in February 2015.
