「INITIUM NOVUM」 ——校友合唱團的新氣象

聖保羅男女中學校友會在2024年5月5日於香港演藝學院舉行了一場盛大的音樂會。是次音樂會得以順利舉行，全賴各方校友的鼎力支持及音樂會籌委會的莫大功勞。當日，音樂廳座無虛席，眾多校內和校外的嘉賓好友到場支持，亦有不少家長攜同子女前來觀賞，場面相當熱鬧。台上，合唱團和管弦樂團的演奏充滿生氣和活力，小朋友穿上別致的民族服飾演唱；台下，觀眾席傳來陣陣歡聲笑語和熱烈掌聲。這次音樂會是自2019年後校友會舉辦的首場演出，也是聖保羅近年來其中一次最大型的校友活動。音樂會的成功不僅表達了聖保羅人對音樂的熱愛，更彰顯了聖保羅這個大家庭的情誼和團結。

筆者是今次校友管弦樂團的首席，這天訪問了趙學文博士Elena (2006) 及廖梓承先生Jason (2014) 兩位校友。Elena和Jason都是這場音樂會的核心籌備成員，而合唱團也在表演中演繹了他們的原創樂曲。仲夏黃昏，筆者與兩位談談在籌備音樂會期間遇到的挑戰和領會，並淺談他們作為音樂人的心得。

音樂會理念與選曲



Elena 過往多次為校友合唱團擔任鋼琴和管風琴伴奏。在這場音樂會中，她更擔當了幕後籌備工作和團員招募的角色。在訪問中，Elena 分享了這次音樂會的籌劃理念。由於校友會數年沒有舉辦音樂會，所以這次與籌委會構思音樂會就是希望能透過音樂平台，重新凝聚聖保羅這個大家庭，讓大家一起享受音樂，更重要的是希望能透過這次音樂會，鼓勵新一輩校友參與更多校友會的活動，把聖保羅的音樂面貌傳承下去。Elena 特別提到，除了一眾校友的演出外，校友會很榮幸能邀請到聖保羅男女中學管弦樂團和校友兒童合唱團一起表演。這種大家聚首一堂的玩樂精神，正正是四十多年前羅怡基校長創立校友合唱團的夢想。

在音樂選材方面，Elena 和 Jason 與籌委會為構思演奏樂曲確實花了不少心思。他們不僅揀選了大家耳熟能詳的作品，如《Gloria》、《New World Symphony》、《Keep the Home Fires Burning》和《It's a Small World》，同時也加入了新的音樂元素，如《Psalm 23》和《月光光》。這些音樂都緊扣了是次音樂會的主題「Initium Novum」，寓意「新開始、新氣象」和「對未來的盼望」。Elena 和 Jason 期望大家互相分享音樂，在天父的帶領下繼續發揚「信、望、愛」精神。

作為首度擔任校友音樂會指揮的Jason，與校友會這次合作又有甚麼感受呢？Jason說他十分高興能在這次跟一眾校友前輩合作，認識了很多新朋友，並感謝各位對他的信任。他稱讚校友們在整個排練過程中非常團結，新舊成員一拍即合、默契相當。在前後僅一個多月的排練中，每個人都能把多年來累積的音樂細胞盡情發揮。即使這數年校友會沒有大型演出，這場表演都一如既往般保持水準。Jason認為團隊合作在音樂演奏中相當重要，作為指揮，除了在音樂技巧上的指導外，更關鍵的是要讓團員感受到音樂帶來的歡樂，才能讓音樂感動大家。

Five Quick Questions for Elena

What is the best part of being a composer-pianist?

I get to put on different hats and work as a fuller musician. I find great joy in the creative process of composing, but then also relish the opportunity to bring those works to life on stage.

What is your favourite place for composing music?

I do my best compositions at the piano with pen and paper. I also find getting out for a long walk incredibly inspiring.

What hours during the day are you most creative?

I am definitely an early bird. I find that my mind is the sharpest and the most focused in the earlier hours of the day.

What is the hardest part about being a composer-pianist?

It takes time for thoughts and concepts to mature. When the pressure of composing the work is great enough, the thoughts come out then I write. However, this process takes a long period of time and I find practising other composers' works during the times I write my own music distracting, as the muscle memory from existing works disturbs my own harmonic language. I would need to have a very clear mind.

If there's one thing you would like to ask your favourite composer, what would that be?

JS Bach. I am in awe of the sheer quantity and quality of his output. I would love to understand his creative process as to how he was able to generate such a constant flow of brilliant musical ideas. Even the smallest insight into his mind would be invaluable.



Five Quick Questions for Jason

Who are some of your top musical influences?

1900-1930 French music, JS Bach, Brahms, Sibelius and Stravinsky have been the major music influences on my musical style and approach.

How do you overcome stage fright?

I do not experience stage fright very often. When that happens, I try to take some deep breaths to calm my nerves before going on stage.

How do you prepare a concert with little rehearsal time?

The key is a combination of prioritisation and mental preparation. I do a deep analysis of the score to uncover trouble spots. I also mentally rehearse different performance scenarios which would allow me to game out different scenarios and have contingency plans at the ready.

What do you like to do when you're not playing music?

I enjoy doing simple relaxing activities like reading or watching leisure videos to unwind.

How do you ensure that you are physically prepared for the demands of conducting?

Adequate rest and recovery are crucial for me as a conductor and performer. I make sure that I get enough sleep and take care of my body so I can meet the physical demands of leading an ensemble.

CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR 2024 COHORT OF DSE & IB GRADUATES ON THEIR EXCELLENT RESULTS AND UNIVERSITY OFFERS

HKDSE 2024

We are pleased to announce the results of our DSE graduates this year. We have two perfect scorers attaining level 5** in all three core subjects and "Attained" in C.S.^, three elective subjects and the Mathematics extended module. One other student attained level 5** in five of their subjects and "Attained" in C.S.^, and the Mathematics extended module. A total of 18 students attained level 5** in four or more of their subjects.

95.7% of our students have qualified for JUPAS degree course.

Summary of results as follows:

- No. of students: 116
- No. of level 5**: 157; 1.35 level 5** per student
- No. of level 5 or above (5**, 5*, 5): 511; 4.41 level 5 or above per student
- 94.8% of our students attained level 5 or above in English Language
- 56.9% of our students attained level 5 or above in Chinese Language
- 71.6% of our students attained level 5 or above in Mathematics

UNIVERSITY OFFERS

We would like to celebrate the incredible achievements of our graduating Form 6 students. The Class of 2024 has shown remarkable determination and commitment in their pursuit of academic excellence and we couldn't be prouder of all that they have accomplished. Despite the challenges of the past few years, our seniors have risen to the occasion and been accepted into the top universities around the world. SPCC continues to maintain its reputation as a leading school for Oxbridge offers, keeping 1st place in Hong Kong and rising to 6th in the international school category for the number of successful offers to Oxford and Cambridge as mentioned in The Telegraph "The success of every single school in getting pupils into Oxford and Cambridge".

UNIVERSITY OFFERS

In the UK, our students have received 16 Oxbridge offers with offer holders continuing their undergraduate studies in Psychology and Linguistics, Law, Chemistry, Mathematics, Psychology and Behavioural Sciences, Natural Sciences, Economics, Medicine, and Land Economy. Three students were awarded the prestigious Prince Philip Scholarship while one student has been further recognised with the Sir Edward Youde Memorial Scholarship. SPCC students have also earned admission to other prestigious universities in the UK including Imperial College London (17), LSE (7), UCL (35), University of Bristol (9) and University of Edinburgh (20).

SPCC students have spearheaded inspiring community initiatives that have gained them admission into some of the most highly selective universities in the world. This has led to an impressive list of offers in the US along with well-deserved scholarships. We have one student who will attend Harvard University on a full scholarship. Another student will attend Columbia University as a Rabi Scholar (awarded to a small number of incoming freshmen who demonstrate exceptional promise in the sciences) and has also received the AmCham Charitable Foundation Lyn Edinger U.S. Studies Scholarship. Other offers that SPCC students have received include Cornell University (4) (Tanner Dean's Scholar), Stanford University (full scholarship), University of Pennsylvania, Dartmouth College, Duke University (2), Northwestern University, Rice University (Shepherd Society Award), Vanderbilt University (Crescere Aude), UCLA, UC Berkeley (3), UC San Diego (6), Northeastern University, Johns Hopkins Peabody Institute (Premiere Talent Scholarship), and the University of Southern California amongst other highly-selective schools in the US.

Students have also received many offers and accolades from universities in Canada such as the University of Toronto (International Scholar Award, International Merit Admission Award), McGill University, University of Waterloo, University of Ottawa, Western University and the University of British Columbia (UBC International Major Entrance Scholarship, Outstanding International Student Award).

One student will attend Keio University in Japan while two students have received offers from the University of Hong Kong – University of British Columbia dual degree program for commerce.



校友合唱團在台上表演了三首曲目。第一首曲目是選自韓德爾《彌賽亞》第十四至第十六章，女高音獨唱部分由羅欣珮女士（2001）演出。歌詞內容呼應崇拜主題——天使報耶穌降生的喜訊給牧羊人。以《Glory to God》樂章大合唱作結，講述在至高之處榮耀歸於上帝，在地上平安歸於祂所喜悅的人。第二首曲目《O Holy Night》，男高音獨唱部分由羅章先生（1966）演出。男高音熟悉的獨唱旋律，配合合唱團的和聲，令會眾置身於耶穌降生的那夜。曲目是一首非常著名的聖誕頌歌，作曲家 Adolphe Adam 在 1847 年為法國詩歌《聖誕午夜》譜曲。歌詞描述主耶穌在伯利恆誕生的情景，眾星在聖善夜光明地照耀着，歡悅的心靈散佈在聖嬰誕生的馬槽旁，東方博士把禮物獻呈給救世主，並永遠稱頌祂的名。第三首曲目 Angels' Carol 由著名英國作曲家 John Rutter 寫詞譜曲。《天使頌歌》共分為三個段落，起初唱出聽見天使歌聲的期盼，接着道來耶穌的降生，並為世界帶來希望與和平。歌曲運用齊唱、疊唱、輪唱等手法，不同聲部相互應和，讓整首樂曲更具層次感，配搭輕快悅耳的旋律，將聖誕時節的期盼及溫暖傳播眾人。



當晚另一個壓軸表演，是疫情期間久久未有演出機會的校友兒童合唱團。校友兒童合唱團今次有超過四十位小朋友參加演出，很高興女兒也能參與其中，享受合唱的樂趣，他們獻唱的曲目是《This Little Light of Mine》。每一位小朋友帶着天真爛漫的笑容歡喜快樂地歌唱，最後更舉起手上的小蠟燭燃點了整個教堂，比喻主的話語成為我們腳前的燈和路上的光。最後，陳國強牧師為會眾祝福，校友會合唱團和校友兒童合唱團一起帶領會眾高唱《O Come, All Ye Faithful》，為這個聖誕展開美麗的序幕，讓我們反思聖誕的意義及紀念主的救恩。



LIVING THE OLYMPIC DREAM – IN CONVERSATION WITH SPCC'S FENCING STAR DAPHNE CHAN

It was an honour to spend a delightful August afternoon with Daphne (2023) and her mother, chatting in the school hall about her most recent and momentous achievement – to represent Hong Kong in the 2024 Paris Olympics. Despite her open, friendly, lively and almost carefree demeanour, it is clear that behind it lies the countless hours of training, immeasurable hard work and sacrifices that have culminated in her incredible achievements to date. At the remarkably young age of 19, she reached Top 16 on her Olympic debut, currently ranked 24th in the world and is an Asian Games Bronze Medallist. Daphne has simply won our hearts; we are big fans and will continue to cheer her on! Please read below for our interview with Daphne and her mother, Mrs Chan.



Editor (E): How intense was the preparations for the Olympics?

Daphne (DC): Many fencing athletes had four years to prepare for the Olympics, whereas I only had one and a half years of preparation time. It was the most intense and a whirlwind experience, so I plan to just rest up a little after all this!

E: Why did you only get one and a half years to prepare?

DC: COVID was a big disruption to my sporting schedule since I couldn't travel for international competitions with all the travel restrictions. On top of that, my focus was on the junior category, and it wasn't until the end of 2022 that I started participating in senior Olympic-qualifying competitions. The Olympics became an attainable goal for me after I did well in the World Series. I made a big leap, advancing to day two and ending up in top 32, which bumped up my world ranking. Soon after, I realised my dream when I got one of the two individual qualifying tickets in the Asia region, beating the Korean hopeful, to enter the Olympics. It was the best surprise of my life!

E: Tell us how you felt at Paris?

DC: Fencing is truly the most exciting and thrilling sport! I was determined to enjoy the event and process once I arrived in Paris. It was such a special opportunity for me to be there and I didn't actually feel too nervous on the days of the competitions.

E: Can you walk us through your entire fencing career? When did you pick up this sport?

DC: I started fencing when I was six years old, my last year of kindergarten. My mother introduced me to the sport based on the recommendation from a family friend. Back then, fencing was not popular in Hong Kong, and the gear was not child-friendly. So, contrary to love-at-first-sight, I cried the minute I was geared up for my first fencing experience. It was so intimidating and scary! But I stuck with it, and here we are today! I'm so thankful I found the sport I love.

Mrs Chan: Daphne was a very active and lively girl. As fencing requires both active physical exertion and a calm mind, I thought the sport would be very fitting for her. I like that it's strategic like playing chess while giving her excellent physical exercise.

E: How important is winning to you?

DC: Winning is not the most important, but I don't like to lose! If winning is the only goal I had, I would not know how to enjoy myself. However, at the same time, it's normal to want to succeed. Each victory I've achieved along the way has given me the drive to pursue fencing at higher and higher levels.



E: What is the key lesson you learned from fencing?

DC: I'm actually a very impatient person, and through fencing, I learned the importance of staying calm under pressure.

E: What was your typical training day like? How did you fit in the demands of balancing school and your training?

DC: I have been training at the Hong Kong Sports Institute since I was in Form 1. I would train for five hours a day from 4:30pm to 9:30pm during the weekdays, three times a week, with an hour break in between for dinner. I would then do my homework at 10:30pm, and I always insisted on sleeping at 11:30pm, as I know the importance of being disciplined with my rest as an athlete.

I learned to have good self-discipline and to never leave my homework and assignments until the last minute. While I was able to manage schoolwork and training, I did sacrifice a lot of my personal time. I gave up my other sports such as swimming and badminton towards the end of Primary School to focus on fencing. I gave up countless hang-outs with friends on the weekends. While I was unhappy at the time, I now see that those sacrifices were worth it in the end.

E: Who were your biggest supporters in this journey?

DC: In sports, I understand that hard work and effort do not always come back as desired outcome in equal measure. In fact, sometimes the effort may not even come to much fruition, so I'm very happy that, in my case, the hard work paid off. I am fortunate to have supportive parents. They accompanied me to all my competitions, both locally and overseas. Therefore, having my parents in Paris, seated in the Grand Palais watching me compete, was the most touching moment for all of us. Also, this dream would not have been accomplished without the support of my school SPCC, and the university I'll be attending in the United States.

The long-lasting friendships I've made during the 12 years I spent in SPCC are something I treasure. A lot of times, especially when I was juggling all the pressures from the competitions, going to school and spending time with my friends became a sanctuary for me, always lifting my spirits.

E: When was the turning point for you in fencing when you decided to pursue global-level competitions?

DC: The turning point for me was when I entered U14 international competition in France at the age of 14. I competed from 8am to 8pm that day, and winning gold in that tournament gave me confidence to continue pushing myself further in fencing.

E: What is your most memorable event in fencing?

DC: Attending the Olympics in Paris this year has to be the most memorable experience of my life! Having the chance to compete in the Olympics is the end goal for every athlete, and I was able to do this at the age of 19. I am very satisfied that I won one match and advanced to the top 16. I am not sure if this will be my first or the last time at the Olympics, but it was an incredibly joyful experience for me to treasure.

Mrs Chan: We are grateful to God for the doors that opened, allowing Daphne to participate in the Olympics. Looking back, she was in the right place at the right time to realise this Olympic dream. So much was arranged by the Heavenly Father, even our seats at the Olympics in Paris happened to be the best seats to cheer and support Daphne.

E: How do you overcome hard times?

DC: I'm an optimist at core and I am able to get over things very quickly, especially after a good night's sleep!

E: What are your plans after Paris?

DC: I believe I will continue with fencing. I am also looking forward to starting my first year in university to study business, but at the same time, I can't think too far ahead.

E: Any final words of advice for our readers?

DC: My advice to all St. Paulian's who are reading this article is to never give up on chasing your dreams because, trust me, some of them do come true!

今年是中法建交六十周年，中、法兩國都舉辦了許多慶祝活動。在這些慶典中，深受收藏界注目並被視為今年該界大事的，是我們1966屆簡永楨學兄應法國吉美博物館邀請，舉辦了名為《簡素為絢》Au Coeur de la Couleur的專題展覽，展出了他二百多件單色瓷珍藏。

簡永楨學兄是一位著名收藏家，並為《竹月堂》的主人及以此為名，珍藏希臘古錢幣、水彩畫、茶具等等。而在其藏品中，最豐富及最著名乃單色瓷。

《簡素為絢》展覽於6月10日開幕，展期至9月16日。我們三十多個定居世界各地的同屆（1966班）同學幸得簡學兄邀請，參加了展覽的開幕典禮、11日的專家導賞、12日的研討會，及17日在凡爾賽宮舉行的晚宴及管風琴獨奏音樂會。

參觀了簡學兄的二百多件珍藏，令我明白為甚麼單色瓷是簡學兄及其他瓷器藏家的摯愛。單色瓷，顧名思義，就是純色瓷器，沒有任何彩色花紋式樣點綴，通常以極簡約的設計，配以單一色釉而成。其中奧妙及令人着迷

之處，就是它是對工藝、原料、色釉和形制有極致嚴謹至善的要求。正如世界著名瓷器研究專家、著有多本瓷器研究書籍的康蕊君女士 (Regina Krahl) 在 12 日的研討會中所言：「單色釉器不留情面，胎體或釉色的任何瑕疵，製造、燒製或設計本身的任何缺點，都會影響器物的整體視覺效果。單色釉將我們的注意力集中在工藝質素、表面觸感以及造型和諧等方面。如果我們被瓷器的彩釉紋飾分散了注意力，上述這些就不會受到那麼多的關注。這種明顯的減少增加了對陶瓷匠師的要求，也集中了觀賞者的注意力，他們更有可能體驗到器物的所有層面。單色釉是『少即是多』原則的典型代表。」

色彩方面，邢、定窯之白釉，明永樂之甜白釉，汝、官、哥窯等各種青釉，清純雋雅，淡逸安靜，使人忘卻世間煩囂。其他單色釉如：祭紅、豇豆紅、霽藍、孔雀

藍、嬌黃、檸檬黃、茄皮紫、茶葉末等等，則展現出嬌艷華美，韻味悠長。所以我覺得單色釉瓷器是中華文化美學的精髓典範：含蓄卻絢爛，內斂中綻放。



簡學兄藏品不但豐，更是精。很多展品都是該色釉的絕品，我只舉例兩件世上獨一無二的僅存品，如圖①的北宋綠釉鳳首壺，它是定窯出品，這是根據1969年於河北省保定市定縣靜志寺地宮出土的破碎器物佐證的。定窯以白釉為多，綠釉十分罕見。世上僅有三件從破碎殘片還原的定窯綠釉器皿，以及一件存於故宮博物館的殘片。這件綠釉鳳首壺，是世上僅存完整品。另一件世上唯一的展品是明永樂時期的甜白釉暗花纏枝蓮托八吉祥僧帽壺（見圖②）。通常瓷壺都因蓋子形積小容易失落而不完整，這件簡學兄藏品卻是帶原裝蓋子的完整品，加上佛教八吉祥的紋樣及腹部的永樂篆書款，世上集此三特點的僅此一件，所以彌足珍貴。

展覽的陳設設計與展品及展覽名稱《簡素為絢》十分契合。日本女設計師山添奈織運用簡約設計，以凸顯展品的典雅素淨。而展品的安排以顏色分類，並在該色釉系列之前，詳細說明該色釉之特點、呈色劑原料等，使參觀者能夠清楚瞭解每種色釉的特別之處。這樣的安排讓人可以仔細欣賞每一種色釉，而不會把多種不同顏色釉放在一起，避免參觀者感到眼花繚亂。

而展覽把同一色釉但來自不同朝代的瓷器放在一起，顯示了同一色釉在不同朝代的演變，同時凸顯了瓷器工藝的進步。如以上附圖的例子中，展示了兩個透明釉杯。圖③是明嘉靖透明釉暗花雲龍紋鐘式杯，圖④是清康熙透明釉刻劃雲龍紋小杯。將這兩者並排擺放，就可以清楚看到工藝之演變進程。

另一個我十分欣賞的就是於展類說明中引用有關單色瓷的古詩，以及一幅描述瓷器製作七十多個工序的長卷畫，使我對瓷器欣賞和製作過程有了更深入的理解。

在6月12日的研討會上，幾位世界知名專家，如前述的康蕊君女士 (Regina Krah) 、現任上海古陶瓷科學技術研究會副理事長、上海博物館陶瓷研究部主任陸明華先生，以及前香港中文大學文物館館長及教授、中國文化研究所名譽研究員林業強先生，就青、紅、黃瓷等主題進行演講。他們向來賓提供了豐富的資料，令我這位門外漢對不同釉色瓷器的演變及發展有進一步認識。名家說名器，盡顯簡學兄的細心安排，臻善臻美的精神，值得我們敬佩。

在6月17日的凡爾賽宮盛宴上，有百多位賓客參加，簡學兄與其千金簡佩玲 (1995) 熱情招待我們同學，特聘專業講解員引領我們參觀幾個知名大廳。同學們都十分興奮，能在沒有其他遊客的情況下，盡情參觀欣賞宮中裝潢和藝術品，以及在燈光映照下金碧輝煌的鏡廳拍照留念，真是一個非常難得的機會。

晚宴後，簡學兄還特地邀請了著名管風琴演奏家 Baptiste Robin 在 Chapelle Royale de Versailles 獨奏。我在欣賞音樂之餘，禁不住提醒自己好好記着這晚上的盛宴，以便日後回味。

簡永楨學兄的成就和收藏，為世公認，法國文化部特為此向簡學兄頒授了文化騎士勳章。

簡學兄不單是聖保羅男女中學同學們之光，更是香港和中華文化之光！
