

團魂凝聚聖樂之光——記校友合唱團與樂團 MUSIQUE CHORALE SACRÉE音樂會 從零到盛放的百日征程

2025年5月5日,香港理工大學賽馬會綜藝館燈光徐徐暗下。指揮廖梓丞(2014)雙臂揚起,現場彌漫着莊 嚴而充滿期待的氛圍。母校校友合唱團與校友管弦樂團奏出第一個磅礴音符,Lili Boulanger《Hymne au Soleil》 如曙光劃破黑暗,也為法國五月藝術節聯辦的法國聖樂音樂會——Musique Chorale Sacrée 揭開序幕。此刻, 舞台上近百名表演者心中湧動的是歷經百日努力、從無到有將音符與夢想匯聚成光的感動。這不僅是一場音樂 會,更是一段由團魂凝聚、讓聖樂之光綻放的百日征程。

序幕:藝術使命與雙重挑戰的交匯

這場音樂盛宴始於一份文化使命的邀約。與法國五月藝術節聯合主辦 Musique Chorale Sacrée,是一次極具挑 戰的藝術嘗試。曲目設計涵蓋多部法國聖樂經典:從Gabriel Fauré的《Cantique de Jean Racine》,到Maurice Duruflé 結構複雜的《Quatre Motets Sur Des Thèmes Grégoriens》;從Lili Boulanger光輝燦爛的《Hymne au Soleil》,到César Franck宏大莊嚴的《Mass in A Major》,每一部作品都是對演出水準的考驗。

與此同時,校友管弦樂團也面臨着組織與藝術的雙重壓力。新任樂團經理陳俊光(2004)接替了已服務超過十 年之久的潘碩衡(1992),不僅需統籌整個樂團的運營與後勤,還需以演奏者身份投入排練與演出。這種雙重 身份帶來獨特視角,但也伴隨着重大責任:如何在時間緊迫的情況下,將分散各界的校友音樂人重新凝聚起 來,共同點亮這盞聖樂之光?

第一樂章:聲部中的微光與樂團的星光匯聚

合唱團各聲部在此次藝術征程中,以驚人的凝聚力譜寫了共創的樂章。不僅是女低音聲部,從男高音、男低音 到女高音,無不展現對藝術完美的執着追求。

團員們自主精進,自發組織的加練成為提升的關鍵:男高音主動集結,細膩打磨獨唱段落與法文咬字;男低音 相約額外練習,深入熟悉旋律與和聲基礎;女高音則排練後留下,反覆雕琢作品中高難度的音程跳躍。此外, 男女高音聲部更經常進行聯合練習,精心調校聲部間的平衡與音色融合,體現了聲部間的默契共鳴和見證了 「以歌傳光」的團魂精神。







女低音聲部作為「光之樞紐」,組長——校友合唱團副主席趙學文(2006)及劉羨棋(2008)自2月起便並肩作 戰,從預約排練場地到歌曲練習,確保每一位團員都能閃耀自己的光芒。面對如Duruflé的《Tota Pulchra Es》中 需抽調八人支援第二女高音、其餘七人穩守聲部基礎的挑戰,她們更展現了高度的適應力與團隊意識。女低音 的交流群組亦成為重要的資源樞紐,凝聚了許多無私貢獻: 校友會主席梁詠詩 (1985) 邀法籍家屬錄製 《Hymne au Soleil》發音範例、校友合唱團主席任永欣(1991)錄製練習聲帶、團員也積極分享各式學習資源……這些珍 貴資料如明燈,指引着整體前進的方向。

另一方面,樂團經理從1月中旬開始艱難的招募工作。最初的反應並不理想,許多過往團員因事務繁忙無法參 與。然而,憑藉耐心逐一溝通,並在趙學文的協助下,最終成功組建了一支具規模的樂團。過程中,樂譜、樂 器、運輸等挑戰接踵而至,但每一次困難都成為團魂凝聚的契機,讓點點星光最終匯成璀璨星河。

協奏部:幕後工作的光與影

藝術之光的完美呈現,離不開幕後的精密協作。合唱團方面,場刊策劃團隊確保所有資訊準確無誤;票務工 作團隊則精心平衡藝術價值與實際運營需求。每一個細節都如同光線中的稜鏡,需要精準調校才能折射出完 美色彩。

樂團管理同樣面臨諸多實務挑戰。排練場地的預約與確認、大型樂器的運輸與安置、音響設備的租借與調試, 這些工作雖處在陰影之中,卻是光芒得以綻放的基礎。樂團經理主動承擔電子琴與擴音器的搬運任務,確保器 材始終處於可用狀態,如同默默守護光亮的燈塔。

兩團之間的溝通協調更是光之交匯的關鍵。從曲目安排到舞台站位調整,從音響平衡到演出服裝統一,每一個 細節都需要雙方多次協商與確認。正是這些幕後點滴的努力,才讓前台藝術之光得以完美綻放。







終曲:聖樂之光的完美綻放

演出當天,後台洋溢着緊張而有序的氛圍。團員們於上午十一時半抵達現場進行走台,下午一時更換至黑演出 服與校友會胸針,彼此整理儀容,氣氛專注而肅穆。當燈光灑落,音樂響起,表演者不再是一個個獨立的個 體,而是融為傳達法國聖樂之光的集體媒介。

弦樂十重奏《Hymne》即使在綵排中未曾齊集十人合練,卻憑藉扎實的音樂功底與臨場應變完美呈現。而合唱團與樂團聯合演出的《Mass in A Major》更將音樂會推至高潮,其中《Panis Angelicus》由男高音獨唱、大提琴與電子琴協作,音聲交融,如同聖光般洗滌人心。從Fauré的靜謐深邃到Boulanger的輝煌燦爛,從Duruflé 的靈性淨明到Franck的壯闊宏大,三個月以來的汗水與努力,最終在舞台上綻放成最耀眼的光芒。

尾聲:光之不滅,樂韻長存

音樂會雖已落幕,但其光芒長存。5月12日,團員們於天后「食得好」舉行慶功宴,為這段非凡旅程畫上圓滿句點。這場盛事的成功,離不開每一位參與者的無私奉獻:指揮的專業領導、團員的刻苦排練、幕後團隊在行政、設計與協調中的精益求精,不僅展現了聖保羅校友的藝術水準,更彰顯了校友網絡的凝聚力和創造力。

對許多參與者而言,這百日征程是一次個人與集體的成長之旅。合唱團聲部組長在多重角色中切換,體會到藝術管理與團隊協作的深層價值;樂團經理則在雙重身份中學會更高效的時間管理與溝通能力,並深刻體會到音樂跨越界別、凝聚人心的力量。演出結束後,許多團員表示希望繼續維持這個音樂大家庭,並已開始籌劃下一次演出。這是一場音樂會的終結,亦是另一段藝術之旅的開始。

正如一位團員所言:「我們不僅演唱了聖樂,更用團魂凝聚了聖樂之光。這道光,將在我們每人心中永遠閃耀。」這段經歷,以及其中所結下的友誼與收穫,已化為每位參與者心中一曲永不落幕的聖詠,持續照亮前行的道路。

CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR 2025 COHORT OF DSE & IB GRADUATES ON THEIR EXCELLENT RESULTS AND UNIVERSITY OFFERS

HKDSE 2025

We are pleased to announce the results of our DSE graduates this year. We have four perfect scorers attaining level 5** in all three core subjects and "Attained" in C.S.^, and three elective subjects. Three of them also attained level 5** in the Mathematics extended module. Three other students attained level 5** in five of their subjects and "Attained" in C.S.^. A total of 14 students attained level 5** in four or more of their subjects.

98.2% of our students have qualified for JUPAS degree course.

Summary of results as follows:

- No. of students: 109
- No. of level 5**: 138; 1.27 level 5** per student
- \bullet No. of level 5 or above (5**, 5*, 5): 474; 4.35 level 5 or above per student
- 86.2% of our students attained level 5 or above in English Language
- 60.6% of our students attained level 5 or above in Chinese Language
- 78.9% of our students attained level 5 or above in Mathematics
- ^ Citizenship and Social Development (C.S.)

- 1. The average score of our 2025 cohort is 42.4 (out of a full score of 45).

UNIVERSITY OFFERS

We are happy to announce the extraordinary successes of our graduating Form 6 students. The Class of 2025 has demonstrated unwavering fortitude, resilience, and a relentless pursuit of academic excellence. Through challenges and triumphs, they have risen above expectations, embodying the very best of SPCC's spirit.

We are immensely proud to announce that our seniors have once again secured outstanding university placements, with acceptances to the world's most prestigious institutions. SPCC continues to lead as Hong Kong's top school for Oxbridge offers, a testament to our students' brilliance and dedication.

[^] Starting from the May 2023 assessment session for the Diploma Programme (DP) and Career-related Programme (CP), the data on the number of students achieving 45 points will no longer be included in the statistical bulletin. Additionally, the results will be presented based on the proportion of points falling within each band of 5.

Despite continuous changes to the testing requirements for top universities in the UK, our Form 6 students have adapted well and shown determination to achieve their fullest potential. 12 students received offers to study at Cambridge in subjects such as Land Economy, Mathematics, Natural Sciences, Law, Medicine; two have been awarded with the Prince Philip Scholarship. We will have two students matriculating to Oxford to study Law and PPE. We are also grateful that our students have been welcomed at other reputable universities in the UK including UCL (46), Imperial College London (15), LSE (11), University of Bristol (20), King's College London (40) and Royal Veterinary College (4).

From educating the public on sunsetting industries in Hong Kong through organising tours to conducting research on the indirect detection of dark matter with neutrinos, SPCC students have distinguished themselves through meaningful community engagements that highlight each of their unique strengths. Their leadership in impactful initiatives has contributed to their successful admissions to Ivy League schools as well as other highly-selective schools. We will have three students who will matriculate to the University of Pennsylvania, one of whom will attend the Wharton School of Business on a full scholarship, the HKSAF Scholarship and the AmCham Charitable Foundation Lyn Edinger US Studies Scholarship. Others have also received offers from Cornell University, Princeton University, Johns Hopkins University, UCLA (5), UC Berkeley, UC San Diego, University of Southern California (2), University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign (2), New York University and Boston University. We also have students whose musical and artistic gifts have been recognised by the Berklee College of Music, Pratt Institute, Parsons School of Design and Savannah College of Art and Design.

Outside of the UK and the US, our students have also received offers from the triple degree program with University of Southern California – Bocconi University – HKUST (World Bachelor of Business), the University of Hong Kong – Peking University Dual Degree in Law as well as the Chinese University of Hong Kong – Tsinghua University Dual Degree in Economics, University of Toronto (International Scholar Award), McGill University, University of British Columbia, University of Sydney, and Monash University.

We are confident that our students will continue to make their mark on university campuses all around the world. Congratulations to the Class of 2025!

Jennifer shared her insights on equipping students for local and overseas university interviews and added excitement to the session by challenging mentees to answer her interview questions on the spot.



TRAILBLAZER SERIES #7

COMING HOME: JOYCE FUNG'S ART BRINGS SPCC'S HISTORY TO LIFE

Joyce Fung didn't plan to become an artist when she was a student at SPCC. Back then, she was focused on her studies and had yet to discover her passion for art. It wasn't until she went to Harvard University that she began exploring different subjects - like psychology, archaeology, philosophy, and photography - and realised that art was the best way for her to connect ideas, memories, and people.

After Harvard, Joyce spent time in Berlin, where she lived as an artist, visiting museums and creating her own artwork. Later, she studied at Peking University and taught in the architecture department. These experiences helped shape her creative style, which combines thinking deeply about space and memory with hands-on design.

A New Invitation to Return

Joyce came back to SPCC not just as a visitor, but as the school's first artist-in-residence. She was invited by the Director of Music to take part in a new initiative that aimed to bring art into the school in a fresh and meaningful way. The idea was to have an artist live and work on campus, creating something that connects with the school's history and everyday life.

Joyce saw this as a chance to give back to the place that shaped her. "I didn't want to just hang paintings on a wall," she says. "I wanted to create something that lives with the school."





Turning Buildings into Stories

Joyce began by walking around the campus, looking closely at the buildings and studying old photos. She noticed that many parts of the school had changed or disappeared. Her goal was to bring those memories back by turning architectural features into furniture – objects that people could use, sit on, and gather around.

One of Joyce's first pieces was a bench made from the wooden door that used to be part of the old school hall. The door had beautiful carvings and a unique arch, but it had been removed during renovations.

Joyce studied the wooden door in photographs from the school archive and transformed it into a bench. She used the arch as the backrest, the sides panels as the seat, and kept the central carvings as decoration. Now, instead of being forgotten, the door is part of everyday life again.

Another piece came from Joyce's own experience working at SPCC. Without a studio, she set up her workspace on the staircase leading from the entrance to the current school hall. Her laptop was placed on the staircase landing and the railing occasionally served as her desk. She later designed a piece of furniture based on that staircase. It can be used as a desk, bench, or standing table. It's a reminder that even ordinary spaces can be full of meaning.

Learning Together with Students

Joyce didn't work alone. She ran workshops with students, helping them notice the school's architecture and design furniture inspired by what they observed. "Sometimes the students show me things I've never noticed."

In one workshop, students played a game where they compared old and new photos of the school. They spotted differences and discovered details they had never seen before – like a crest, fireplace, or pattern in the bricks. Two students were inspired by the fireplace in the music room. One designed a desk, and the other created a chair.

A Message to Alumni: Come Back, Give Back

Joyce's work has brought people together. Teachers, staff, and students have shared stories and memories. Alumni who hadn't visited for a long time came back to see the project. Some were inspired to get involved.

"It's not just about making furniture," Joyce says. "It's about building a home together."

At the heart of Joyce's work lies a simple but powerful idea: we can always see things differently. Even places we know well - like our old school - can surprise us if we look closely.

Joyce's story is an invitation to all alumni: come back, take a fresh look, and help shape the future of SPCC.


